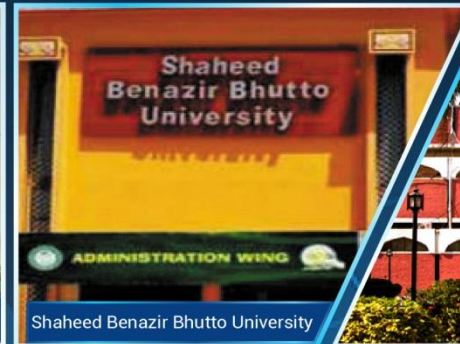
Following the trend set by IS&T Department, other provincial assemblies also tried to opt for virtual sessions.

Establishment of e-Portal

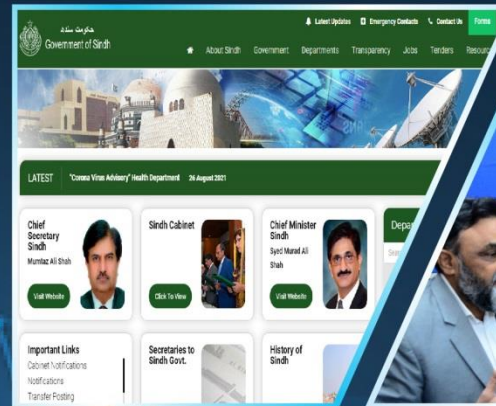
The most authentic and valid one-stop resource of information by the Government of Sindh

This centralized **e-Portal** of Government of Sindh comprises of websites of all departments of Government of Sindh with the following features:

- Online availability of forms (improve public services delivery, reduce services delivery costs)
- Increase data storage
- Every department capable to upload and change contents
- To increase manifold the number of users that can be logged in and can have unique official Support for mobile computing devices

This ADP Scheme has been completed as per scope / objectives defined in approved PC-I. According to Government's prescribed procedures, PC-IV of the scheme has been prepared and ready to submit to P&D Department for its approval in order to convert the regular budget for its maintenance in future.

The new Sindh Portal has been launched on 8th September 2021.



Installation of Security Surveillance Cameras at Worship Places of Minorities

(Project under implementation)

Unfortunately, Pakistan has been through a tough time due to the terrorism activities and minority worship places has also become a victim of these attacks since last decade. Sindh government has been making every effort to give complete protection to the minority area because safeguarding their lives, worship places and properties is our first and foremost duty. Sindh Government with the collaboration of IS&T Department and Minority Affairs Department have made the following arrangements;

- Installation of CCTV Cameras at 253 worship places of Minority Communities in Sindh
- Providing 24/7 Surveillance of worship places in every region of Sindh



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Internet / Wi-Fi facilities within the premises of Sindh Secretariat

Information, Science & Technology Department has already deployed establishment of internet services project in 2008 and currently it is under process for its upgradation and revamping with the more latest technologies with high bandwidth for increasing efficiency in the government working.



Video Conferencing System in Sindh

Installing and Up-grading of existing Video conferencing System with National Telecommunication Corporation on G2G basis at 94 sites, that include:

- Installing of new VC System and establishment of Server / Data Center at different government offices.

IT Lab & Wi-Fi Facilitation Center at Umerkot / Kunri

(Project under implementation)

A New Reliance on Virtual Life is impossible without Open Access to IT Labs and Wi-Fi

Objectives

Umerkot is one of the promising city of Sindh with huge talent and young potential and delivering Wi-Fi access and IT Labs is the initial step towards the horizon of success. The main objective of the project to establish state-of-the-art IT Lab & Wi-Fi facilitation Center where masses / citizens of the Umerkot / Kunri area can enjoy free of cost internet facility. This initiative will be a great support for E-learning and E-commerce to promote the students and business community of Umerkot.



Information & Computing Technology System at Pakistan Steel Cadet College, Karachi

IT knowledge and training is an integral part of every field of education, Information Science & Technology Department, Sindh strives to attribute the cadet colleges of Sindh with advanced IT infrastructure. Latest machinery equipment for Labs are set up at the college premises to provide the IT related education so that the cadets can meet the Challenges of 21st Century. The main components of the Project include:

- Computer Lab along with allied accessories
- Equipping the college with furniture and fixture.
- Set up of Security System and CCTV camera to beef up the security of college



Implementation of e-Governance in Livestock & Fisheries Department Government of Sindh

Livestock and Fisheries Department contributes a significant amount to the national economy and is considered as valuable asset of Pakistan. The fishery sector alone adds 1% to annual GDP and provides jobs to 1% of total population. That is why Government of Sindh has taken a plunge to introduce advanced technology for the upgradation of this sector.

Under the project, a feasibility study is to be conducted in Sindh Livestock in order to provide timely assistance to Livestock and Poultry farmers through ICT based services such as Kissan Call Center and SMS information service.

After completion of the feasibility report, the PC-I of the project is under process of its approval.



Domicile & PRC Automation Project

Under Public Private Partnership (PPP)

The Domicile & PRC Automation Project should have centralized database which will reside at central server system. The front-end software application with features of biometric system will be connected indefinitely with central database system. Therefore, the new automated system will not only store data electronically but will be powered with authenticity checks to ensure transparency, error free and no duplication of domicile & PRC issuance. The project shall be rolled out division-wise throughout the Sindh province. Following are some of the glimpses from the implementation of this project;

- Automated process of Domicile & PRC
- Paperless Real-time system for General Public
- Centralized Repository of Domiciles and Digital Records.
- Overcome the Duplication of Dual Domiciles
- Platform Independent Datasets.
- Domicile History anywhere anytime

After completion of the feasibility report with the approval of competent authority, the PC-I is under preparation taking NADRA onboard.



Mainstreaming of e-Government/ Strengthening of Government, Program Management and Quality Assurance Practices at IT Department

Information, Science & Technology Department through its ADP scheme **Mainstreaming of e-Government / Strengthening of Government, Program Management and Quality Assurance Practices at IT Department** prepared feasibility reports/draft PC-1(s) in order to automate all the Departments of Government of Sindh keeping in view their actual requirement from initial level to evaluate the existing IT working upto the recommendations & preparation of PC-1(s) according to each department needs/requirements for next 5 years. In this regard, consultant company was hired after observing all codal formalities according to SPPRA (existing rules). This task has been completed positively and is ready for implementation in coordination with all the Departments of Government of Sindh & same would be done after approval of PC-1(s) by Planning & Development Board Sindh.

The Information, Science & Technology Department Sindh feels proud to successfully prepare these comprehensive feasibility reports first time in Pakistan and is positive to share these reports with the provinces & national level as well so that the same may be replicated befitting the requirements. It might be a quick plan to move forward for e-governance & digitization / automation of the Government's working.

Hospital Management Information System (HMIS) deployed and operational at Civil Hospital Karachi

The Hospital Management Information System will be capable of:

- Providing integration & connectivity among all patient contact points / departments.
- Serve the operational, tactical and strategic information needs of the hospital consolidate procedures, systems & services
- Up-gradation of Network Equipment.
- Replacement of core application servers, as the accessories of faulty server are hard to find in open market.
- Provision of Wi-Fi network with the existing Local Area Network in the main working area of the Hospital.

This project has been recommended to Federal Government for its replication in other provincial public hospitals.



Introduction of e-Policing System in Sindh

(Currently operational by Sindh Police)

As per the security prerequisites, Sindh IS&TD has taken initiatives to introduce e-Policing for instant help and assistance of its people. This project has been successfully implemented in the entire Sindh Police and Sindh Prisons Department.

Following components have been deployed successfully throughout Sindh as from now onwards Police Department is responsible of its operations and maintenance.

- Development of Sindh Police ERP, Traffic Police ERP, Prison Management System
- 15 Madadgar Call Centre
- e-Driving License & Violation Ticketing System
- Traffic Management System
- Procurement of Hardware and Networking in Police and Prison Departments
- Establishment of FM Radio
- Establishment of Video Conferencing System
- Internet Connectivity
- Establishment of e-Police Directorate
- Sindh Police Website

Recommended for replication in other provinces.

Initially the IS&T Department has built the boundary walls & initial master plan. Currently, preparation of detailed feasibility report is under process through a consortium of consultants (under PPP mode of Finance Department, Govt. of Sindh).

Sindh Investment Department is currently engaged to prepare main master plan of complete land of Education City. As some previous coordinates of the land has been changed, therefore, as soon as further plan is cleared by Investment Department GoS, the designing / implementation plan will be initiated accordingly. The project will attract FDI and International IT firms to produce business opportunities on large scale that would also create the great job opportunities for the masses of the province.



Capacity Building of IT for Sindh Secretariat Employees through IBA, Karachi.
